- Determine and select materials for any conservation intervention, applying various means of rescue measures depending on the degree of corrosion in all excavation findings and materials of monuments,
- Operate machinery and equipment used for the conservation of objects/cultural heritage monuments,
- Organise and implement the conservation stages of cultural heritage objects,
- Implement the legal framework concerning the techniques and the materials applied in the conservation and preservation of cultural heritage as well as the professional ethics dictated by sectorial and professional organisations,
- Determine possible dangers of environmental pollution in the workplace as well as occupational hazards and take measures for avoiding them, implementing rules for the safety and health of the workers in the workplace,
- Fill in the essential documents and/or computer data logs.

4. Range of occupations accessible to the holder of the certificate ³

The holder of this certificate can be employed in the public and the private sector and, more specifically, in Antiquities Services and newer monuments inspectorates of the Greek Ministry of Culture as well as the Archaeological Resources and Expropriation Fund, in private and public museums, art galleries and religious collections, in private conservation workshops for antiquities and works of art, in technical and construction companies which undertake public works (restorations, underground), in local government organisations and in the art trade (e.g. art dealers).
