- Describe accurately the digital and analog cameras of small and large format and list their advantages and disadvantages.
- Recognize the analog and digital camera operation and accessories.
- List the types of films depending on their attributes and use and their particularities.
- Distinguish and describe the photo shooting, the black and white and colored processing techniques of an analog and digital camera.
- Know the basic aspects of freehand drawing, color and synthesis of a photographic project.
- Recognize how visual perception and visual communication in photography work.
- Report on the basic principles of advertising and marketing in photographer's profession.
- Recognize the methods of digital photo shooting, digital processing and digital printing of photos.

SKILLS

- Combine the shutter speed-diaphragm-sensitivity of a photosensitive material in all types of photo shooting.
- Select and effectively handle the appropriate equipment, depending on the photo shooting type.
- Handle all sources of light, artificial and natural ones, depending on the type and subject of photo shooting.
- Handle all types of cameras in landscape shots, portraits, still nature, fashion, events (baptism, wedding), reporting, architecture and industrial photography.
- Manage camera digital processing programs.
- Develop film and print out photos in a dark room laboratory.
- Undertake shooting and processing of digital and analog photos

COMPETENCES

- Undertake photo shooting, reporting, social events, of private and professional character and is responsible for the work quality.
- Cooperate with other specialties professionals (hairdressers, graphic designers, fashion designers, artistic supervisors), for complex professional photo shooting.

4. Range of occupations accessible to the holder of the certificate³

The VET graduate of this specialty may work at an applied photography studio, of the public and private sector, as a freelance professional in different technical photography specialties.

The Diploma is recognized as a formal qualification for appointment in the public sector, in the Secondary Education graduate category, by virtue of the PD 50/2001 (Government Gazette 39/A/5-3-2001), as in effect.
